Motion by Peckham, second by Herbst to approve the minutes of the previous meeting on 3/16/20. Motion carried 4-0.

Consider approval or denial of various license applications

Rasmussen noted there were no denial recommendations for licenses this month and the list of applications was short due to many businesses currently closed.

Motion by McElhaney, second by Peckham to approve the licenses on the list as recommended by staff. Motion carried 4-0.

Consider request for approval of a variance to Chicken Keeping License - Theran Peterson

Rasmussen stated the renderings of the back yard in the packet show the larger coop requested. She commented the picture of the finished coop is attractive looking.

Peckham commented the pictures were good, but the application did not state the distance the coop would be from the eastern property line. He had also wanted to know if they had talked with their neighbors, so he contacted Humane Officer Bishop and she indicated she inspected the site and recommends approval.

Motion by Peckham, second by Herbst to approve the variance for to the Chicken Keeping License. Motion carried 4-0.

Communications

Rasmussen noted the tavern activities and fire department reports were emailed to committee members for their information rather than agendaized since they were not considered essential business.

Peckham stated the tavern activities report showed there were additional problems at Hutch's and Newch's Eatery and felt the owners should be invited to appear before the committee because their demerit points have reached 100. Rasmussen directed staff to include the report on the May agenda so this can be discussed at that time.

Subject: Outdoor Beer Garden
Date: May 14, 2020

I have attached two documents showing the general layout of the proposed additional outdoor seating for beverage service in a beer garden atmosphere at Whitewater Music Hall. Given restrictions of social distancing, we feel we are uniquely prepared to offer a variety of flexible outdoor arrangements that offer plenty of space and peace of mind to our staff and guests while still maintaining careful alcohol beverage service standards and a much needed venue for Wausau residents and tourists to relax and enjoy the nice weather. We would like the permitted area to include the front sidewalk (not the pavement) of the main west entrance and the south parking area. Alcohol and coffee beverages will be served indoors at either of our two locations (upstairs at the original indoor bar or downstairs at the small service room on the southeast corner of the building) and carried to tables in seating areas outside in the south lot. Our service room downstairs will include a small tap service area, handwashing station for employees, and access to restrooms for staff and guests.

Specifics include:

- Offering outdoor table seating with ample space between tables (6+ foot minimum radius around each table) in the large, secluded south parking lot of Whitewater Music Hall. The parking lot will be closed to vehicle traffic at the narrow passage at the southwest corner of the building.
- Utilizing natural barriers to control access to beer garden. There is no public thoroughfare in contact with any part of the triangular beer garden. The space is bounded by the building to the north, a guardrail and train tracks to the west/southwest, and a tall retaining wall to the east. Staff will be able to survey the entire space from any perspective.
- Installing prominent signs at front walkway of main entrance to indoor space upstairs, at barrier to cars to the beer garden, and at several points at the edge of the small green space on the south indicating boundaries of alcohol beverage possession.
- Service hours during daylight only, approximately 12pm to 9pm. No increase in permitted occupancy of building is requested. Will adhere to all Badger Bounceback requirements as well.

We hope this will serve as a starting point to arrive at a workable plan with the City of Wausau to offer guests a safe, relaxing, and fun outlet.

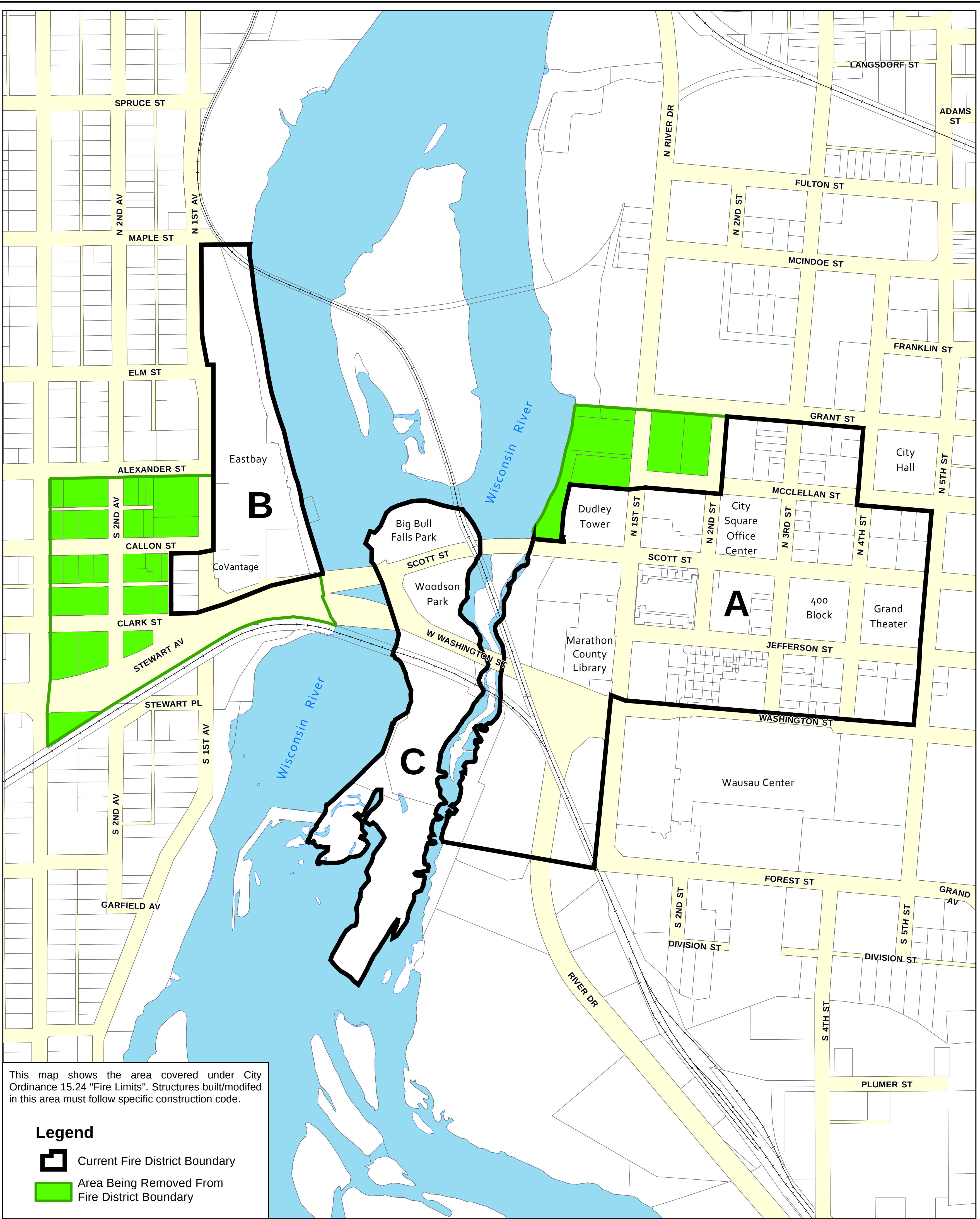
Purpose: To modify fire district map by eliminating unimproved properties on the near west side and a portion on the near east side.

Facts / Considerations:

1. The Wausau fire district has been in existence since at least the 1970's. We have 3 sections of the downtown in the district; the near east side, Clark Island area, and the near west side.
2. The district was intended to require a higher safety design in regard to building materials and electrical wiring to create safer buildings in the downtown area. Several blocks in the city have buildings sharing exterior walls as property lines. The potential for fire to jump from building to building is greater in wood construction where buildings share walls and have openings in them for HVAC, electrical, even door or window openings.
3. The district was last amended in 2009 to remove the area south of Forest Street. At the time a new multi-tenant facility was being proposed. Today it is the multi-tenant facility that holds Anytime Fitness and McDonald's.
4. Wisconsin state building codes are now uniformly enforced and updated every 3-6 years to keep up with the national standards. Safety factors in building construction and fire sprinklers are more prominent and widespread than previous building codes.
5. Staff from the Inspections and Fire Department have discussed modifications to the Fire District. The area proposed to be removed from the fire district is primarily vacant property or existing buildings that have setbacks to property lines. Please see 2020 Fire District Changes Proposed map.

Recommendation: Your approval is requested for:

1. Fire District map modification as shown. A legal description is being modified for changes to the municipal code in chapter 15.24. We will provide as an ordinance when available.

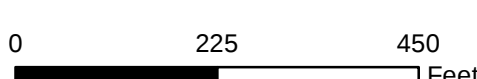
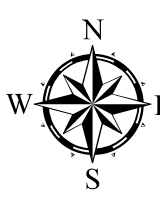

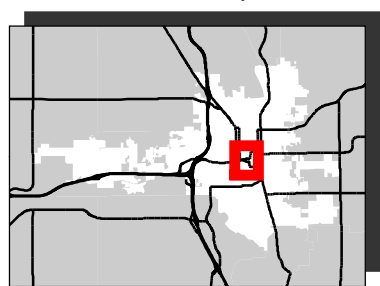

The Common Council of the City of Wausau do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Section 15.24.010 Boundaries, subsections (a) and (b) are hereby repealed and replaced to read as follows:

15.24.010 Boundaries. All that part of the city included within the following described territory shall be known as the fire district:

- (a) Commencing at the intersection of the Easterly line of the Wisconsin River and the South right-of-way of Forest Street extended Westerly, the point of beginning; Thence East, along said South right-of-way extended Westerly, to the West right-of-way of North 1st Street; thence North, along said West right-of-way, to the North right-of-way of Washington Street; thence East, along said North right-of-way, to the West right-of-way of North 5th Street; thence North, along said West right-of-way, to the South right-of-way of McClellan Street; thence West, along said South right-of-way, to the West right-of-way of North 4th Street; thence North, along said West right-of-way, to the South right-of-way of Grant Street; thence West, along said South right-of-way, to the East right-of-way of North 2nd Street; thence South, along said East right-of-way, to said South right-of-way of McClellan Street; thence West, along said South right-of-way, to the East right-of-way of North 1st Street; thence Southwesterly, to the intersection of the West right-of-way of said North 1st Street and the north line of Lot 1 of Certified Survey Map No. 14100 recorded in the Office of Register of Deeds for Marathon County in Volume 62 of Certified Survey Maps on Page 107; thence West, along said North line, to the West line of said Lot 1; thence South, along said West line, to the North right-of-way of Scott Street; thence West, along said North right-of-way to said Easterly line of the Wisconsin River; thence Southerly, along said Easterly line, to said South right-of-way of Forest Street extended Westerly, the point of beginning.
- (b) Commencing at the intersection of the Westerly line of the Wisconsin River and the Northerly right-of-way of Stewart Avenue, the point of beginning; Thence Westerly and Southwesterly, along said Northerly right-of-way, to the North right-of-way of Clark Street; thence West, along said North right-of-way, to a line 108 feet west of and parallel with the East line of Block 2 of A. Stewart's Addition to Wausau;

thence North, along said parallel line, to the South right-of-way of Callon Street; thence East, along said North right-of-way, to the East right-of-way of South 1st Avenue; thence North, along said East right-of-way and along the East right-of-way of North 1st Avenue, to the South right-of-way of Maple Street extended Easterly; thence East, along said South right-of-way extended Easterly, to said Westerly line of the Wisconsin River; thence Southerly, along said Westerly line, to said Northerly right-of-way of Stewart Avenue, the point of beginning.

Subsection (c) remains unaffected by these changes.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of publication.

COMMENTS REGARDING POSSIBLE TEMPORARY
EXPANSION OF OUTDOOR FOOD AND ALCOHOL SERVICE Nathan Miller
Assistant City Attorney

- Mark Craig, General Manager of Compass Properties has asked the City to consider amending ordinances and taking certain other actions to temporarily assist restaurants in the 300 and 400 Blocks of North 3rd Street to increase outdoor dining and alcohol service opportunities upon the expiration or other termination of restrictions imposed as a result of the State of Wisconsin's Emergency Order relating to the coronavirus/COVID-19.
- Consideration of this proposal also creates the opportunity to assess what steps might be able to be taken on a temporary basis with respect to outdoor dining service for the benefit of all restaurants City-wide to assist them during the period of "re-opening."
- A copy of an email from Mark Craig dated May 11, 2020, outlining the steps and action being sought from the City is attached.
- Modifications to parking restrictions being requested on these blocks would appropriately be considered initially by CISM. However, there is no CISM meeting being held this month. The Common Council could consider these parking changes at its meeting upon a suspension of the rules, or CISM could be requested to call a special meeting.

While the Mayor does have emergency powers under the City of Wausau Proclamation of State of Emergency to temporarily suspend or modify applicable ordinances or resolutions to allow immediate response to meet the needs of the extraordinary exiting conditions for as long as the public health emergency remains in effect in the state, it may well be that Governor Evers could lift, or the Wisconsin Supreme Court may strike down, the state's emergency order, causing the expiration of the City's proclamation and the Mayor's temporary authority.

- Significant to the proposal for expanded outdoor food and alcohol service are state laws governing the sale of alcohol beverages:
 - Class "B" beer licensees may sell beer to consumers for on-premises or off-premises consumption.
 - "Class B" licensees may sell intoxicating liquor to consumers by the glass for on-premises consumption. City ordinance W.M.C. §5.64.065 (as permitted by state law) further permits the sale of intoxicating liquor *in original, unopened containers* for consumption away from the premises in excess of 4 liters and wine or beer in any quantity.
 - "Carry-ins" are prohibited at a licensed premises.
 - Alcohol *may only be sold on the licensed and particularly described premises under a licensee's control* for which the license has been issued.
 - A licensed "bartender" must be in the same room or area as an unlicensed server, near enough to see and talk with the unlicensed server in order to be able to immediately supervise that person.
 - A license holder may apply to change the premises upon submission of a written request to amend the premises. It is within the discretion of the governing body

to approve or disapprove the change. However, a municipality may not unilaterally reduce the description of a premises and must either follow state procedures relating to revoke, suspend or renew, or negotiate the consent of the licensee to reduce the premises. *Wisconsin Dolls, LLC v. Town of Dell Prairie*, 2012 WI 76. We are currently researching whether this consent can come prior to, and be conditioned upon amendment of the premises.

- A number of City ordinances are implicated as a result of the proposal. Changes to these ordinances would also apply City-wide to all restaurants. The following is a sample of those types of provisions (which would require amendment as applicable in order to recommend/approve aspects of the proposal).
 - Provisions in W.M.C. ch. 5.63 relating to sidewalk cafes in the central business district. These provisions include restrictions confining outdoor cafes to the public right of way that immediately adjoins the licensed premises; need to maintain clear passage for pedestrians and customers for ingress and egress and clearance of fire exits; requirements for removal of tables and chairs when café is not in operation; restrictions from the café encroaching on sidewalk adjacent to other property.
 - Provisions of W.M.C. §5.64.035 restricting alcohol beverages generally on public sidewalk outside of approved sidewalk café areas.
 - W.M.C. §5.64.036 prohibiting drive-up alcohol sales which has been temporarily suspended by the City during the state of emergency pursuant to Governor Ever's Emergency Order #8 and emergency guidance issued thereunder by the Department of Revenue permitting sales of alcohol beverages on a "carry out" basis, as long as fact-to-face sales are made.
 - Provisions of W.M.C. §9.04.025 prohibiting the consumption or possession of intoxicating liquor or fermented malt beverage while on any public street, sidewalk or other public right of way, or in or upon The 400 Block. Alcohol consumption is permitted on the 400 Block and adjoining sidewalks only between 4:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. and during Special Events upon request of the event organizer and as approved under the Special Events permit (and for a period of two hours before the event and one hour after, or as otherwise approved by the PH&S Committee). Exemptions for a special event must be requested 60 days in advance by both the PH&S Committee and Common Council). (Similar rules regarding the 400 Block are set forth in W.M.C. §9.20.020 governing regulation of persons in public parks).

Tara,

Thank you. I've copied Tyler from Townies into this, along with Blake from the River District and Dave Eckmann from the Chamber.

I did send a longer email (below) to the Mayor earlier today.

We are seeking approval for ways to add outdoor seating and enhance to the curbside/delivery aspects for our numerous restaurants in the 300 and 400 blocks of 3rd Street:

- 1) Allow seating to extend beyond the boundaries of their store fronts along 3rd Street (with neighbor's permission).
- 2) Permit closing the street in the 300 & 400 blocks every Wednesday night from 4:30pm to 8:30pm for "Dining in the Street". Allowing restaurants to place tables and chairs in the street to serve customers. Those sections could be stanchioned off with small plastic table tents to mark seating for different restaurants. They would each be logically and intuitively placed in the areas in front of each restaurant. Alcohol and food would be served.
- 3) Allow The Mint Café and Townies to utilize portions of the 400 Block patio with the tables and chairs for their patrons. Those two sections could be stanchion off and plastic table tents to mark their section. Alcohol and food would be served.
- 4) Add two 15-minute stalls in the 300 Block adjacent to the existing 15-minute stall in front of Ciao to better accommodate curbside and pick-up meals for Jalapeno's, Ciao, Lemongrass, Polito's Pizza and Sweet Lola's. The 15-minute stall on the north end of the 300 block could be eliminated.
- 5) Remove the 4' tall bollards along 3rd Street to create more seating/table locations for outdoor dining.
- 6) Allow restaurants along 3rd Street to close-off 2-3 parking stalls adjacent to their sidewalk seating, to increase outdoor seating space.

These six steps will increase the space needed for outdoor dining and enhance curbside/delivery opportunities as our downtown restaurants re-open to the "new normal". We only have approximately 100 days to take advantage of outdoor dining in our climate. Having a nimble city government to respond quickly in May, will allow each location to better prepare and have a greater chance of success.

Section 1. That Section 5.04.030 Investigation of certain applicants, is hereby amended to read as follows:

5.04.030 Investigation of certain applicants; issuance of licenses and permits. (a) The provisions of this chapter section shall apply to applications for and licenses under Chapter 125 of the Wisconsin Statutes ~~beer and liquor licenses, peddler and transient merchant licenses, and applications and licenses for public vehicle businesses and permits for operation of public vehicles under ch. 5.72 of this Code.~~ taxicab and taxicab operator licenses.

(b) Except as otherwise provided herein, upon receipt of each application it shall be referred to the chief of police, who shall immediately investigate the applicant's business and moral character and the premises sought to be licensed within seventy-two hours after it has been filed with the clerk.

(c) The chief of police shall furnish to the clerk and the public health & safety committee his/her written recommendation relating to the grant or denial of the application based upon the investigation. Subject to Sections 111.321, 111.322 and 111.335 of the Wisconsin Statutes, If, as a result of such investigation, the applicant's character or business responsibility are found to be unsatisfactory, or if it is found by the chief of police that it would be against the best interest of the public to license the premises for which a license is sought, the clerk shall refer the same to the license committee of the common council who shall ~~the public health & safety committee shall then consider the application and make a recommendation to the common council to approve or disapprove the same, and return the application to the clerk. Upon grant or denial of the license or permit by the common council,~~ The the clerk shall notify the applicant that his/her application is approved or disapproved and if no license is issued, shall remit one-half of the license or permit fees paid, retaining the remainder of the fees as reimbursement to the city for the cost of such investigation.

(d) In the case of an application for an operator's license, if, as a result of the investigation the character and business responsibility of the applicant and the premises sought to be licensed are found to be satisfactory and complies with the requirements of Section 125.04(5) of the Wisconsin Statutes related to operators' licenses, the chief of police shall endorse on the application his/her approval and return the same to the clerk, who is hereby delegated authority to issue such operator's license without the need for common council approval. shall thereupon deliver to the applicant his license without.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect on the day after its publication.

COMMENTS REGARDING PROPOSED
AMENDMENTS TO W.M.C. §5.04.030
INVESTIGATION OF CERTAIN APPLICANTS

- On March 3, 2020, the Wisconsin State Legislature passed 2019 Wisconsin Act 116 permitting municipal governing bodies to authorize a municipal official to issue operator's licenses.
- At its March 16, 2020, meeting, the Public Health & Safety Committee considered the option offered by Act 166 and approved the City Attorney's Office to prepare an ordinance to proceed to the Common Council allowing the City Clerk's Office to issue operator's licenses, where the application for a license has been recommended for approval by the Chief of Police.
- In the process of drafting the change to City ordinance, this office discovered that a City ordinance already provided for the issuance of certain licenses by the Clerk's office, including operator's licenses. This ordinance, W.M.C. §5.04.030, was carried over into the current codification of the Wausau Municipal Code in 1968. See, W.M.C. §1.01.010.
- This provision, however, prior to the passage of Act 166, would have been in conflict with Wis. Stat. §125.17(1) which required operator's licenses to be issued by the "municipal governing body." While W.M.C. §5.04.030 purported to provide the City Clerk's office authority to issue operator's licenses, in recent memory the practice of the City has been that all such licenses are reviewed and recommended or denied for approval by the Public Health & Safety Committee and then forwarded to the Common Council, notwithstanding the ordinance provisions.
- Given the passage of Act 166 and the existence of W.M.C. §5.04.030, it would not be necessary for any ordinance to now proceed to Common Council to delegate this authority to issue operator's licenses to the City Clerk's Office at this time.
- However, there are a number of other infirmities contained in W.M.C. §5.04.030, as it purports to provide the City Clerk with the authority to issue all licenses for beer and liquor upon approval by the Chief of Police. This is not in accord with state statutes which require Class "A," "Class A," Class "B," "Class B," and Class "C" licenses to be issued by the municipal governing body. However, notwithstanding the provisions of the ordinance, this is not the City's practice in issuing such licenses, which are in fact approved or disapproved by the Common Council in accordance with the provisions of state law.
- As these other infirmities were not considered by the Public Health & Safety Committee at its March meeting, a proposed amendment to W.M.C. §5.04.030 is now brought forward to resolve this issue, as well as align other provisions of the ordinance with City practice and procedure.

Dear whom it may concern,

I'm writing to you to urge you to consider allowing our restaurants in our central BID district to expand their sidewalk café seating and waive any permit fees. The effects of COVID-19 are evident in our downtown, with many businesses at risk of closing their doors permanently. A [Wausau River District survey](#) conducted in April identified that 25% of businesses local within the district are at risk of closing within two months. The actions we take in the coming weeks and months will have a long-term impact on our downtown's vitality.

As businesses are reopening, we are encouraging them to utilize the [reopening guidelines provided by the WEDC](#). The industry-specific guidelines recommend that restaurants space table 6 ft apart, have a capacity of six guests per table, and reduce overall capacity as much as possible. This reduction in indoor seating will have a negative financial impact on our businesses. By allowing businesses to extend their outdoor seating capacity on the sidewalk, this enables them to generate more revenue and increase their chances of surviving this global pandemic. Also, alfresco dining is perceived to be a safer option and would improve the overall image of downtown Wausau as a safe destination.

An example of this can be found in [Sturgeon Bay](#), who recently waived both sidewalk café permits and liquor license fees. Both La Crosse and Menomonie are exploring similar measures, including extending sidewalk cafes and using parking spaces for extra dining.

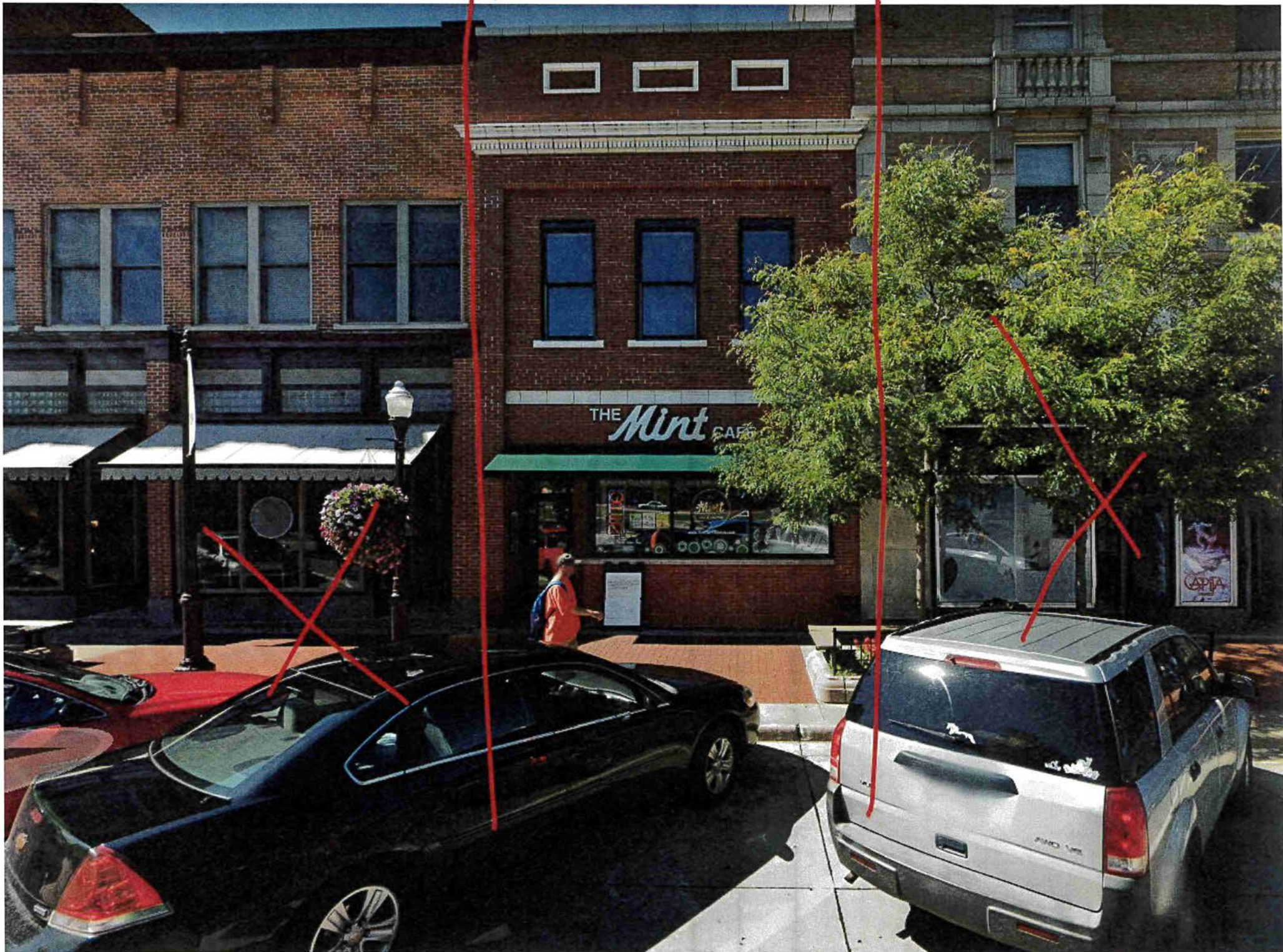
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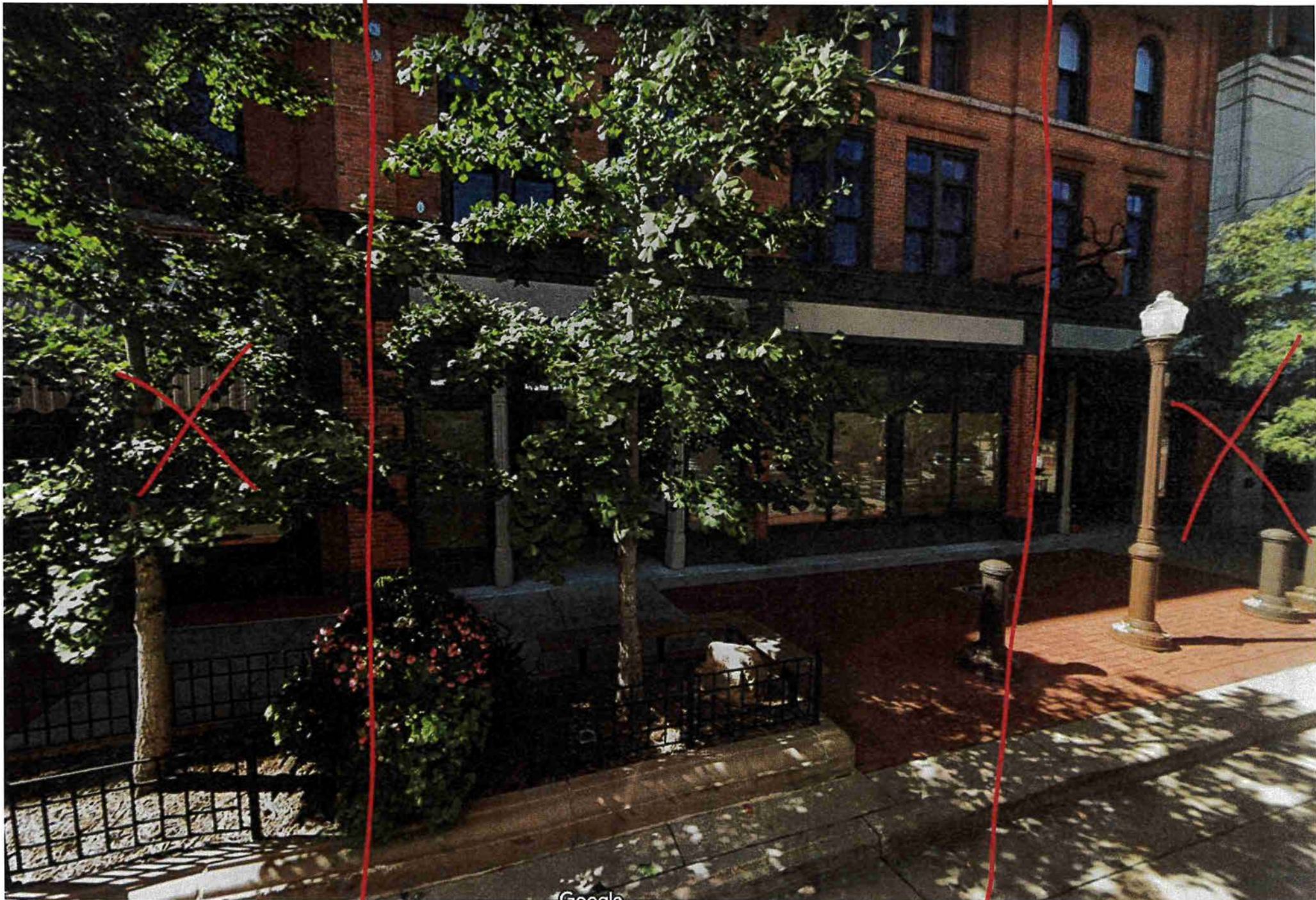

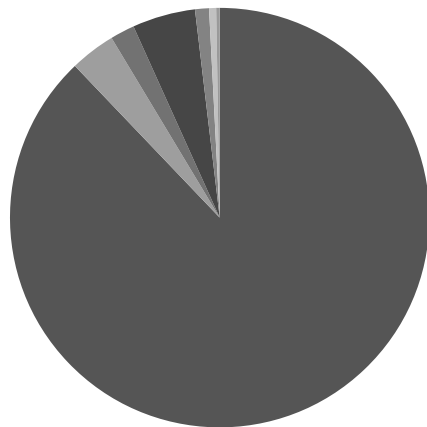

The inspections for the month of March, 2020, had not been conducted before the ordered closure of the bars.

NOTABLE INCIDENTS AT TAVERNS TO WHICH POLICE WERE DISPATCHED.

Bob and Randy's Bar, 1515 N. 6th Street

- (1) *Case #2002318, 03/07/2020 at 8:16 AM:* An **employee** called to report a theft. After watching the video, and suspect known to Officers is seen removing a tip jar from the bar, hiding it under his coat and leaving. The male was referred to the DA's Office for theft charges.
- (2) *Event #20036853, 03/24/2020 at 4:46 PM:* An anonymous called complained that the bar was open in violation of COVID-19 closure orders, because there were lights on inside, and the parking lot was "half-full" with cars. An Officer responded, and found only one employee on site, managing take out purchases. The cars were from tenants that live above the bar. No violation noted.



Cop Shoppe Pub, 701 Washington Street

- (1) *Event #20027221, 03/01/2020 at 6:01 PM:* An anonymous caller complained about a vehicle parked across the sidewalk. The driver had entered the bar. On arrival of the Officer, the vehicle was gone.
- (2) *Case #20002258, 03/06/2020 at 2:11 AM:* Officers responded to a commercial burglar alarm. The building was found to be secure and a false alarm report was generated.
- (3) *Case #20002369, 03/09/2020 at 3:17 AM:* Officers responded to a commercial burglar alarm. There was an attempt to cancel the alarm, however the Officer had already responded, and another false alarm report was generated.
- (4) *Event #20031397, 03/11/2020 at 12:16 AM:* An anonymous caller complained about loud music from the bar, noting that it happens all the time. Officers responded, and on arrival could barely hear music from the outside. It got worse when the door opened. They were having karaoke. The bartender agreed to shut the windows to help keep the noise down. No further action was taken.
- (5) *Event #20033967, 03/16/2020 at 11:37 PM:* A male citizen responded to the Police Department to report concerns that his drink was drugged while he was at the bar a couple days prior. An Officer took the information and spoke to a bartender. He was going to check with the bartender that had been on duty at the time, and also work with the bar in obtaining video surveillance of the night in question. The inquiry continues.
- (6) *Event #20034312, 03/17/2020 at 7:24 PM:* There were still people in the bar after the ordered shut-down time. Contact was made with the employees on site to gain compliance. They closed at the direction of Officers.

Malarkey's Pub, 412 N. 3rd Street

- (1) *Event #20033280, 03/15/2020 at 2:28 AM:* There was a 9-1-1 call received from the area of the bar. While checking, a loud verbal argument was taking place at the back door to Malarkey's. The incident involved an intoxicated patron from the bar having a confrontation with a vehicle in the parking lot. One of the bouncers/bartenders came outside to find the patron getting "jumped" by the multiple occupants of the vehicle, and pulled the intoxicated patron into the bar, and was yelling at the others from the car when the Police arrived. The occupants of the car stated that the intoxicated patron had tried opening the driver's door and tried getting into the car. The altercation involved removing the male from their vehicle. No one wanted to pursue charges. All involved had been drinking. The vehicle was parked to await a sober driver and the groups were separated.



Oz, 1206 N. 3rd Street

- (1) *Event #20030057, 03/07/2020 at 11:02 PM:* A citizen wanted to speak with an Officer after seeing a person that has a restraining order against the caller. The caller wanted it documented that he thought the person with the restraining order was following him around and seemingly everywhere he goes. The concerns were documented in CAD comments.

Wausau On the Water, 1300 N. River Drive

- (1) *Event #20027162, 03/01/2020 at 2:50 PM:* An employee called for a suspicious person in the business. A male was in the bathroom, shaving his head and dancing. He wouldn't leave. Officers responded and made contact with the male, identified him and escorted him as he voluntarily left.

Roc's Place, 810 S. 3rd Avenue

- (1) *Case #20002616, 03/15/2020 at 1:47 AM:* A person that refused to be identified called to report that there was a large group of people involved in a fight. On arrival, Officers did not observe anything physical going on. On investigation, including watching surveillance of the incident, it was determined that it was a verbal argument, and the people involved had left the scene. Two people were cited for open intoxicants, however the Officers did not determine where the drinks had come from (Roc's or M&R Station), so citation and demerit points were not issued regarding those violations.

Treu's Tic Toc, 1201 W. Thomas Street

- (1) *Case #20002693, 03/19/2020 at 8:33 PM:* Officers responded to make contact with a male in the Marathon County Jail that claimed to have been shot in the leg while outside Treu's Tic Toc bar, on the night on 02/26/2020. The victim was with another male, and they both had warrants, and he had been using drugs, so the incident was not reported at the time of the incident. The Officers were planning on contacting the bar management to ascertain if there was any video of the incident. The suspect was described as a black male, estimated to be approximately 30-35 years old. The suspect obtained the gun from a dark blue, large SUV, with dark tinted windows, loud exhaust and factory wheels.



Hutch's Bar, 4411 Stewart Avenue

- (1) *Event #20034287, 03/17/2020 at 6:54 PM:* Officers found that the bar was still open and serving after the ordered shut-down time. The management was cooperative, closed the bar and patrons left.
- (2) *Event #20035471, 03/20/2020 at 7:35 PM:* Officers stopped at the bar for an extra patrol, as he observed several vehicles in the lot. The doors were locked (Governor's Orders), however the Officer could see six to eight people apparently drinking bottles of beer and glasses of mixed drinks. When the Officer shined his flashlight into the bar, he was able to hear someone inside say that it was the Police. The bartender looked at the Officer, grabbed her phone and then went to the back kitchen area of the bar out of sight. After about five minutes, the bartender reappeared, and allowed Officers inside. She admitted everyone had been drinking, and she did not come to the door because she didn't want the Police inside. The supervisor had a conversation with the owner, who said his daughter was working, and that they had a work meeting earlier in the afternoon. Based on the bartender's behavior, and the recent history of a relatively serious violation, I recommend the assessment of **seventy-five (75) Demerit Points** for failure to cooperate with the Police Chief designee.

Whiskey River Bar & Grill, 5512 Stewart Avenue

- (1) *Event #20027316, 03/02/2020 at 12:40 AM:* An **employee** called to report that a male fell down and was bleeding from the head. Officers and an ambulance responded. On arrival, the Officers found employees yelling at and restraining the male, who had a wound on the back of his head that was bleeding profusely. The male denied medical transport, but allowed the ambulance crew to bandage the wound. On a poor sample, the male tested .197% BrAC. He was released to a responsible person as it was determined the incident was not an "assaultive incident." No information was provided as to whether or not his level of intoxication was reached as a result of being served at the bar. It was noted that the male lives in a nearby apartment, implicating that he may have been drinking elsewhere as well.
- (2) *Event #20034278, 03/17/2020 at 6:46 PM:* The bar was still open and serving patrons after the shut-down order time had passed. Management was cooperative in closing and the patrons left the bar.
- (3) *Event #20035465, 03/20/2020 at 7:24 PM:* An Officer conducted extra patrol of the business as there were many cars in the lot. They turned out to be take-out customers (Friday night), and were practicing good social distancing. Once exception was a male that had been served a drink by bartender Brooke, and was drinking at the bar. It was explained that the order prohibited eating or drinking in the bar, and the issue was resolved by the bartender.



101 Pub, 101 N. 3rd Avenue

- (1) *Event #20026993, 03/01/2020 at 2:21 AM:* Officers were called to respond to the bar in reference to a male that was bleeding. Contact was made with two individuals who were trying to help a third male. The third male had allegedly slipped and fell on some ice downtown, cutting his face. The other two were trying to keep him with them, due to his injuries, however he wanted to leave them, to the point that he was pushing them away, and pushed one down to the ground. The injured male left the scene before Officers arrived, but he was located in the area. Neither the bar nor the friends wanted to pursue any charges, and the male was released to a responsible person at his residence after he denied any type of medical treatment.

Aftershock Bar and Grill, 1418 Lenard Street

- ** Due to recent and ongoing complaints, Officers have been conducting frequent extra patrols of the business. There were a total of 23 extra patrols logged in the month of March. ****
- (1) *Event #20030111, 03/08/2020 at 1:31 AM:* A refused complainant called to report that there were people outside the bar yelling and making noise. An Officer responded, parked some distance away, and approached on foot to gauge the noise level. While observing from a distance, the Officer could hear that there were two people outside the bar talking, but did not feel that the noise was excessive. The noise complaint was not substantiated.

Callon Street Pub, 209 Callon Street

- (1) *Case #20002444, 03/11/2020 at 7:41 AM:* A citizen called to report witnessing someone damage two windows for the bar by throwing a bucket at them. The suspect was located with the assistance of the witness and arrested. The male offered no motive for the damage.

Chatterbox Bar, 102 S. 3rd Avenue

- (1) *Event #20034280, 03/17/2020 at 6:48 PM:* Officers stopped at the bar as there were people inside at the bar, drinking, after the ordered shut-down time. They advised that it was an employee meeting. They cooperatively closed and left the bar.

Labor Temple, 318 S. 3rd Avenue

- (1) *Event #20034234, 03/17/2020 at 5:09 PM:* The bar was still open pending the shut-down order. Management claimed there were unaware of the closure and what it meant. There were still people there waiting for food, and closed once the food was delivered.



Showtime Gentlemen's Club, 1709 Merrill Avenue

- (1) *Case #20002337, 03/06/2020 at 6:37 PM:* A dancer reported that \$75.00 had been stolen from her belongings in the employee area. She had no suspects. The Officer reviewed video from the bar and saw that no one had taken anything from her belongings. The owner noted that the complainant had been fired from the bar and was no longer allowed on the premise.

Newch's Eatery, 1810 Merrill Avenue

- (1) *Event #20030074, 03/07/2020 at 11:53 PM:* Officers had prior knowledge of advertisement that there was going to be a DJ at the bar that night. A call was received regarding the road being difficult to navigate because of the number of cars parked all over the place. Supervisors made contact with management to discuss the issues with a large crowd prior to the event. Officers responded as a result of the traffic complaint. On arrival, Officers immediately came across a male urinating outside. The road was down to one lane, due to cars parked on both sides. Inside the bar, it was totally packed, basically shoulder to shoulder, and very warm. Many people were sweating profusely. A male was seen throwing up in a trash can. Officers estimated there was 300 people in the bar. The owner did not know the capacity, but admitted to selling two packs of 120 wrist bands. According to the Fire Department, the capacity is 99. After the owner was advised of being over the capacity, he did not take immediate action to remove people. Officers gave him a few minutes to begin to take action, and did not notice anyone really leaving. In fact, some people went back into the bar. Officers went back inside, and no action had been taken. The owner was hesitant to ask people to leave since they had paid to come in. After approximately forty five minutes of no action, the Supervisors gave the bar five minutes to take action, or they would close the bar. Once given that warning, the workers went to the DJ booth, and announced that the bar was closing. Officers left once the crowd was down close to the 99 capacity. As a result of exceeding capacity by more than 30%, and the lack of response by management when asked to bring the crowd down to capacity, I recommend **seventy-five (75) Demerit Points** be assessed.
