Noting the presence of a quorum Chairperson Rasmussen called the meeting to order at 5:15 p.m.

Consider approval or denial of various license applications.

Rasmussen stated Terry French, applicant for New Public Transport License, did not appear to appeal the denial recommendation.

Motion by Larson, seconded by Lukens, to approve or deny various licenses as recommended by staff. Motion carried 5-0.

Consider approval or denial of a Class I Special Event License for 2025 Wausau Labor Day Parade.

Rasmussen stated that the organizers of the special event were working with the Wausau Police Department to agree upon a parade route that would be different than previous years. It was stated that the parade route as recommended by the police department would start at Marathon Park and continue down Stewart Avenue to end near the Labor Temple.

Motion by Lukens, seconded by Watson, to approve the Class I event application contingent upon an acceptable delineated route between the organizers and the Police Department. Motion carried 5-0.

Consider approval or denial of Alcohol Beverage License Transfer for Limerick's Pub.

Motion by Larson, seconded by Watson, to approve. Motion carried 5-0.

Discussion and possible action granting temporary extension of premise (Cop Shoppe LTD., agent Tami Ness, d.b.a. Cope Shoppe Pub, 701 Washington Street).

Motion by Watson, seconded by Lukens, to approve. Motion carried 5-0.

Discussion and possible action on approving contract for Wisconsin Hazardous Materials Response System Services with the State of Wisconsin.

Motion by Larson, seconded by Watson, to approve the renewal of the contract. Motion carried 5-0.
