Noting the presence of a quorum, the Chairperson called the meeting to order at 11:01 AM.

1 Consideration of the minutes of the preceding meeting(s).

October 7, 2025 Regular Wausau Water Works Commission Minutes

- Motion to Approve the minutes of October 7, 2025 with edits as discussed by Gelhar, Seconded by Hadley. Motion Passed 4-0.

2 Director's Report on Utility Operations.

Report placed on file.

a. Update on LSL 2025 Construction & 2026 Funding

Lindman summarized the memo from the packet with an update on the Lead Service Line Replacements and 2026 Funding.

Force commented his lead line was replaced and the contractor was professional; work was done well with minimal disturbance.

b. Update on the Solar Array Project and Next Steps

Lindman stated the project is estimated at \$2.8 million, with City Council approving borrowing up to that amount, reduced by any grants or tax credits. A Sole Source request will go to the Finance Committee on 12/9/2025 to hire for engineering services due to tight tax credit deadlines. The proposed solar site is east of the Treatment Plant, with final design details pending. Hadley opposed the sole source approach and questioned the project's ROI citing she is not in favor of the Solar Array Project. Lindman emphasized the need for sole source due to timeliness of the project to begin the construction process before July 2026 to qualify for the tax credit. Force reviewed the project's background, noting prior research, community input, and support for alternative energy despite some neighborhood opposition. The Solar Array Task Force was agreed upon by this Commission. We've done the homework, the payback is not fast, but I have no doubt it'll be successful. I'm happy we are moving ahead with an alternative energy project and will continue to support it.

c. Wastewater- Update on PFAS Test Results for Effluent and Biosolids

Brooks summarized occasional testing was requested by Commissioner Robinson to try and see where the PFAS results would be for the Effluent and Biosolids. Each test result gets submitted to the DNR, they could potentially use those numbers so we'd want to keep these testing more on a reserved side- results in the packet. Moving forward with the new issuance of the WPDES Permit,

we'll be testing the Effluent monthly and Biosolids every 2 months.

d. Wastewater- Headworks Screening Project Update

Brooks summarized a completion date set for October 2026, waiting for more equipment to be delivered, then work would continue to progress.

e. Wastewater- Cherry Street Lift Station Project Update

Brooks summarized the project was at a standstill. There's a bit of underground force main left to construct, the rest of the work would be above ground, then demo of the old lift station and site restoration to follow.

3 Discussion and Possible Action.

a. Approving the Lead Service Line Replacement (LSLR) Reimbursement Resolution for the 2026 Safe Drinking Water Loan and Principal Forgiveness.

Lindman summarized the draft resolution included a total of \$18,979,908. DNR's estimated grant of \$11,332,910 and \$7,646,998 in estimated loan. The resolution ensures the city/utility would be reimbursed for expenses prior to formal loan documents being prepared by the DNR, there'll be a revenue bond like 2025 and principal forgiveness. It's brought here, goes to Finance, then to Council as a joint resolution. Diny clarified DNR's loan interest of 0.25%.

- Motion to Approve the LSLR Reimbursement Resolution for the 2026 Safe Drinking Water Loan and Principal Forgiveness by Hadley, Seconded by Gelhar. Motion Passed 4-0.

4 Discussion and/or Updates.

a. On Construction Updates and Safe Drinking Water Loan Status Update for the Granular Activated Carbon and PFAS Treatment Project.

Wojtkiewicz reported the GAC has been operational for a little over a year. Changes were made to the chemical feed system. Polymer was added as pre-treatment to improve performance. There were 24 leaking air release valves replaced by the contractor at no cost to the city; a few remain. Overall, the project remains under budget. A change order is pending for coating the concrete floor in structure 120 to support long-term maintenance. With GAC, if you don't get a safe bacteriological (Bac-T) testing result, you can't use chlorine to disinfect because it damages the carbon. You'll need to utilize a caustic rinse. We did that with one of the vessels and it damaged the floor. DNR is allowing the floor coating with the loan. The variable frequency drives (VFD) networking are being adjusted to better integrate with the backup generators. Carbon replacement is approaching due to the PFAS breakthrough we're seeing. DNR has approved the use of reactivated carbon through a certified facility that regenerates the used carbon. That will be about 20% cost savings plus transportation costs. We don't have any regeneration facilities nearby; they're in Oklahoma and Pennsylvania. The vendor would replace 1 or 2 vessels with virgin carbon, then we'll replace the remaining vessels with regenerated carbon over time. There are 12 vessels total in a lead/lag configuration, 6 systems of 2 vessels each. The process would be to remove the lead system vessels, then the lag system vessels become the lead. Hadley questioned the cost and amount of changeout required. Wojtkiewicz estimated the cost of carbon changeout is about \$800k to \$1 million. Going into this, we weren't sure DNR would allow reactivated carbon, but now they've said it's allowed. Lindman replied every year, but if we're doing 1 or 2 vessels at a time, it'll be several months to replace all of them. Diny stated we can plan the timing and budget, but it depends on the water flow and usage too.

b. On the Proposed WPDES Draft Permit for the Wastewater Treatment Facility.

Brooks summarized the draft WPDES permit was received November 3rd, DNR allows us 1 week to respond and provide comment with factual inaccuracies. We have Municipal Environmental Group (MEG) review it along with Lindman, Fable and myself, there are some preliminary comments. The reasoning for factual review is to find any discrepancies, errors or contested items before the next process, which is public notice and comment that ends December 22nd. DNR reviews and makes final adjustments by January 2026. The WPDES will require us to collect 2 years of biosolids to form their calculations and limits. Force questioned if there would be any significant changes between the new/old permit. Brooks replied the PFAS testing on the Effluent and Biosolids. They went from the fecal coliform testing on the effluent for the bacteria counts to e-coli, which is a better indicator of the pathogens in the wastewater for recreational users in the Wisconsin river. We did preliminary testing that showed we're below the limits they want to impose. No change in phosphorus. Lindman summarized the permit and requirements are good as can be but there's still some unknowns with PFAS which can be concerning. We'll see how that evolves overtime.

PURPOSE

Drinking Water Division – Director's Report Updates

BACKGROUND

1. Leak detection results for 2025.
 - a. Asterra did 2 scans in 2025, one in March and the other in August. The March scan determined 76 points of interest (poi), of which we found 1 main break, 2 service leaks, and 3 hydrant leaks. The August scan noted 59 poi's, and we found no leaks.
 - b. Westrum Leak Detection performed a city-wide survey the last week of August. He found 4 suspected main breaks, 6 service leaks and 6 leaking hydrants. (leak report attached)
2. In 2025, Staff repaired 26 main breaks and replaced or repaired 32 services.
3. Staff replaced 2744 meters in 2025. The oldest meters replaced were from 1973. Of the 5/3 size household meters changed, about 35% failed to meet WPSC accuracy standards.
4. In 2025, staff completed 7,603 locates.
5. As of 1/27/26, even with the cold snap we haven't yet had any laterals freeze. Staff have, however, been very busy with no water calls due to conditions of customer residences.
6. With the cold came water leaks, staff repaired 5 main breaks and a service leak from 1/21 to 1/26.

Federal Lead and Copper Rule Revisions (LCRR) Update

BACKGROUND

To meet the requirements of the Federal Lead and Copper Rule Revisions (LCRR), in December the water department mailed 7,957 notices to customers with Galvanized (62), Lead (3,518) and Unknown possibly lead (4,377) service laterals. This is an annually recurring requirement, until all services are identified not lead or replaced.

PURPOSE

Headworks Screening Project and Cherry Street Lift Station Updates

BACKGROUND

1. Headworks Screening Project Update:

- Ahern & subcontractors mobilized: 06/16/2025.
- Substantial Completion: 10/15/2026.
- Final Completion: 11/15/2026.
- Hydrodyne Screens were received on 12/11/2025. In preparation for the installation of the new screens, one of the old Huber step screens was decommissioned and removed. Upon removal, it was discovered that the concrete of the influent channel had become compromised over the years by hydrogen sulfide. The influent channel was of 1969 construction. Donohue and Ahern made the decision that a new coating was required prior to the installation of the new Hydrodyne step screen, which required a change order. The change order will include the repair work of both influent channels. Change Order not to exceed \$28,000.00

2. Cherry St. Lift Station project update:

- Integrity mobilized on site: 09/08/2025, Substantial Completion Date: 01/31/2026 (new lift station operating with demo work completed)
- Final Completion Date: 05/15/2026 (all work complete, with grass actively growing)
- Equipment and enclosure were delivered on 12/12/2025. The contractor is currently working on the installation of the control panel with an anticipated start up date of 02/03/2026.

Angela, please consider this email as response to the 30 day public comment period regarding the Wausau Waterworks Wastewater draft WPDES Permit.

Comments and request below:

- 1.) 3.2.1 Sampling Point (Outfall) 001 – Effluent to Wisconsin River
 - E.coli sample frequency on draft listed a sample frequency of 2/Week. Expired permit required a sample frequency of 1/Wk for Fecals and during the E.coli monitoring period it was also 1/Wk.
 - I am requesting that the sampling frequency requirement of E.coli monitoring match that of the expired permit with a sampling frequency of 1/Wk.
- 2.) It is very unfortunate that Wausau Waterworks-Wastewater has still not received its final approval letter from the WDNR with Class A, EQ Biosolids designation. All required information has been submitted to the WDNR along with the final SMP for review and final approval. It has been two years if not longer. We have consistently produced Class A, EQ Sludge. Since the City hasn't received its final approval letter from the WDNR we have been testing Class B AND Class A sludge for the entire duration and it has become very costly. I will not discontinue testing Class B sludge until we receive a final approval letter from the WDNR.
 - Permit Modifications will be necessary at the time Class A, EQ Biosolids approval is received.
- 3.) PFAS/Biosolids sample point clarification needed on Draft Permit: All Sampling Points listed on 4.1 are not discharge points. The PFAS sampling frequency requirement should be indicated on the specific Sampling Point Number listed in 4.1
 - 4.2.1.8 Sludge Monitoring for PFAS: Monitoring shall occur at each sample point when sludge is generated and discharged regardless of the end use (ie. Land applied, hauled to another facility, landfilled). This language is very vague and doesn't define the exact sample point location's required for PFAS sample collection. Needs to be cleaned up to define specific locations of where samples need to be taken.

If I come up with any additional comments over the weekend, I will be sure to submit by 4:30pm on Monday, 12/22/25

Re: Water Rate Comparisons

Lately, I have received several inquiries regarding our rates as compared to other utilities. People believe Wausau has “the highest water rates in the state” which is not true.

The following spreadsheets are Water Bill Comparisons run from the Wisconsin Public Service Commission’s Website. For consistency in comparison the quarterly bill charge was figured at the meter charge plus 18,750 gallons of water used, or about 25 units.

The first sheet is a comparison of water rates for all the utilities in Marathon County. Using the above criteria, Wausau has the 8th highest rate in the county. The second sheet is a comparison of all AB Class utilities. AB Class are those utilities having 4000 or more customers. Of those utilities, Wausau has the 16th highest rates. The last spreadsheet shows all the water utilities in the state. Of the 575 compared, Wausau has the 187th highest rate.

Water rates will be a very dynamic subject for many utilities in the next couple years. There are several pending regulations which could increase costs for treatment and operations. I felt it would be important to show how our rates compare to our neighbors and in the State.

SUBJECT: Update on the solar array project and possible schedule

PURPOSE

Discuss the status of the solar array project and possible schedule moving forward

BACKGROUND

The funding for the solar array project was approved by the City Council in the 2026 budget. The total funding approved is about \$2.8 million of possible borrowing and General Obligation debt. City staff has also applied for a USEPA Grant for the project in the amount of up to \$1.18 million. Results of the grant application results will not be announced until May/June 2026.

The initial strategy was to sole source the engineering/design/bid package preparation in order to meet the deadline of beginning construction prior to July 4, 2026. Doing so would have potentially reduced the amount of regulations/restrictions on the bidding and also allowed the City more time to construct the project and place the project online. The Finance Committee denied the sole source request. Staff prepared a complete RFP for professional engineering services and is soliciting proposals for the work. The proposals will be opened late February and with a contract in place in mid-March. Based on this timeline, we anticipate bidding for construction in June 2026. This will likely be construction starting in August 2026 with completion in 2027. Exact completion is unknown as we do not know the timeline for material ordering and delivery. Missing the July 4, 2026 construction date means we must be fully complete before the end of 2027 to be eligible for any possible tax credits.

Once we have an engineering firm under contract a schedule for project completion will be prepared and the Commission updated, anticipate the April meeting.

SUBJECT: Discussion on the annual Payment in Lieu of Tax (PILOT) paid to the city by Wausau Water Works

PURPOSE

Discuss annual PILOT payment from Wausau Water Works to City

BACKGROUND

Wausau Water Works has historically provided a PILOT payment annually to the City of Wausau. The current PILOT payment is \$1,590,000 from Drinking Water and approximately \$500,000 from wastewater. The PILOT payment for the Drinking Water Division is initially determined by the PSC through their rate review and based on the assets owned by the water utility. Based on this PSC determination, the City council may then determine whether to have that amount paid or change the amount to be paid by passing a resolution of the Common Council. Currently, the PSC has determined a fee of about \$2,000,000 to be paid by the Drinking Water Utility. The city council has frozen the annual payment for 2025 and 2026 at \$1,590,000.
