Approve minutes of the March 23, 2021 meeting

Groat moved to approve the minutes of the March 23rd meeting. Jacobson seconded and the motion passed.

Open bids and make recommendation for 2021 Street Construction Project B

The following bids were received:

Haas Sons, Inc.	\$1,255,048.30
Merrill Gravel & Construction Co.	\$1,286,583.59
Switlick & Sons, Inc.	\$1,412,058.00
A-1 Excavating, Inc.	\$1,496,260.00
Earth, Inc.	\$1,615,354.60

Groat moved to award the contract to the low-qualified bidder, Haas Sons, Inc., in the amount of \$1,255,048.30. Wesolowski seconded and the motion passed.

Make recommendation for Hand Labor Mowing Services for years 2021 through 2025 (Proposals were opened March 16, 2021.)

Mohelnitzky reviewed the proposals received and met with Wesolowski. Revi is a little lower per hour with the biggest difference of \$5 an hour in 2024. Revi is higher in cost per site visit. It would depend on how many cuts they have, number of hours, and number of just site visits. The site visit is when the contractor gets to the site and the property was already mowed; a flat fee is then charged. Wesolowski and Mohelnitzky recommend using Revi as they have been used in the past, have done a good job, and offered a lower per hourly rate.

Wesolowski moved to accept the proposal from Revi. Groat seconded and the motion passed 2-1 with Jacobson the dissenting vote.

Jacobson moved to deny the claims submitted by Kubichek in the amount of \$10,910.01 and \$20,000. Seconded by Groat and the motion passed.

Jacobson moved to deny the claim submitted by Nutter in the amount of \$4,451. Seconded by Groat and the motion passed.

Jacobson moved to deny the claim submitted by Pisteuo Properties in the amount of \$325. Groat seconded and the motion passed.

Jacobson moved to deny the claim submitted by Tress in the amount of \$494.80. Groat seconded and the motion passed.

Groat moved to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Jacobson. Meeting adjourned at approximately 10:20 a.m.
