Reconsider pre-qualifications for the 2020 Fulton Street Extension Project

Lindman explained that last week the Board of Public Works denied Jake's Excavating & Landscaping for pre-qualifying for bidding on the Fulton Street Extension Project. This was based upon performance and follow-up from sewer back-ups that occurred on a project last year. Since the Board's decision, a call took place with Jake's Excavating. Their insurance company was holding up claims. Jake's Excavating provided a written statement that their insurance company will pay the claims and take their own legal action.

Jacobson asked if communication should go out to all the homeowners affected or only to those who have contacted their office. Lindman feels all affected homeowners should be contacted.

Jacobson moved to rescind the denial and approve Jake's Excavating & Landscaping as pre-qualified to bid on the Fulton Street Extension Project contingent upon them paying outstanding claims related to the Sanitary Sewer Interceptor Relay Project. Seconded by Lindman and the motion passed.

Lindman moved to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Groat. Meeting adjourned at approximately 12:35 p.m.
