Noting the presence of a quorum, the Chairperson called the meeting to order at 10:31 AM.

1 Consideration of the minutes of the preceding meeting(s).

06/23/26 Regular Board of Public Works Minutes.

Motion by City Attorney Jacobson, seconded by Public Works Director Lindman, to approve **06/23/26 Regular Board of Public Works Minutes.** Motion Passed 2-0.

2 Discussion and possible action.

a. Open bids and make recommendation for the 2026 Downtown Sidewalk Improvement Project.

The following bids were received:

Pember Companies, Inc.	\$105,799.75
Norcon Corporation	\$127,301.00

Motion by Public Works Director Lindman, seconded by City Attorney Jacobson, to award the contract to Pember Companies in the amount of \$105,799.75. Motion Passed 2-0.

b. 2026 Street Construction Project "A" - Stark Street: Switlick & Sons, Inc., Change Order #1.

Niksich explained that this change order is to establish a pay item for 15" storm sewer. In one location we had to upsize from 12" to 15" for about 40'. There were two other locations; one of 11' and one of 5' to make tie-ins to existing. Approval is recommended. Motion by Public Works Director Lindman, seconded by City Attorney Jacobson, to approve Change Order #1 in the amount of \$5,040.00. Motion Passed 2-0.

c. 2026 Street Construction Project "A" - Stark Street: Switlick & Sons, Inc., Pay Estimate #2.

The quantities and work completed for this pay estimate have been reviewed by the project inspector and project engineer. Motion by Public Works Director Lindman, seconded by City Attorney Jacobson, to approve Pay Estimate #2 in the amount of \$434,994.08. Motion Passed 2-0.

d. 2026 Pavement Marking Project: Brickline Inc., Pay Estimate #1.

This pay estimate was reviewed by Sign Shop staff. Motion by Public Works Director

Lindman, seconded by City Attorney Jacobson, to approve Pay Estimate #1 in the amount of \$105,342.65. Motion Passed 2-0.

- e. 2025 Street Construction Project "B" - Fulton Street/1st Street/2nd Street: Switlick & Sons, Inc., Final Payment.

This pay estimate was reviewed by Project Engineer Niksich. Motion by Public Works Director Lindman, seconded by City Attorney Jacobson, to approve the final payment in the amount of \$8,490.74. Motion Passed 2-0.

- f. Washington Street Siphon Replacement Project: A-1 Excavating LLC, Change Order #4.

When sidewalk was removed during this project, the electrical box in the middle of the sidewalk was determined to need replacement. The change order also includes an extension of the ready for final payment date. This project received some federal funding through the DNR. We are working through the final close-out documents with the DNR and are anticipating having the project closed with the DNR prior to September 1st. Motion by Public Works Director Lindman, seconded by City Attorney Jacobson, to approve Change Order #4 in the amount of \$2,903.25 and approve extending the Ready for Final Payment to September 1, 2026. Motion Passed 2-0.

- g. Washington Street Siphon Replacement Project: A-1 Excavating LLC, Pay Estimate #3.

This pay estimate covers some concrete items, Change Order #1, and release of retainage down to \$1,000.00. Once all the close out documents are cleared, we will release the final retainage. City Attorney Jacobson questioned the negative balance of the project. Project Engineer Niksich explained the project is over because of rock excavation. We bid rock excavation, but also had a supplemental item for rock excavation if we went over or under. Unfortunately, we went over on the rock excavation number, which increased project costs. We are still within the budgeted amount. This was a known potential cost, but was not included in the purchase order. Public Works Director Lindman asked if any of this would be paid by the DNR loan and Project Engineer Niksich confirmed. Motion by Public Works Director Lindman, seconded by City Attorney Jacobson, to approve contingent on verification if a formal change order is needed with the DNR. Motion Passed 2-0.

- h. 2025 Water Treatment Plant Demo: The MRD Group, Inc., Change Order #2.

It was found during the demolition that the two additional buildings also had footings and footing walls below the groundwater table. We always knew that the underground clear well was constructed about 20' into the groundwater. We had brought everything down to the groundwater level. We met with Finance Director Groat and Community Development staff to determine if we wanted to remove the foundation footings because they are not as deep as the clear well. The MRD Group provided a cost to do this. Staff verified with Finance that there was budget available since the demolition cost came in under. The consensus from staff was to move ahead and remove those so potential future development would not have to deal with them. Motion by Public Works Director Lindman, seconded by City Attorney Jacobson, to approve Change Order #2 in the amount of \$136,795.00. Motion Passed 2-0.

3 Adjournment.

Motion by Public Works Director Lindman, seconded by City Attorney Jacobson, to Adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 10:41 AM.

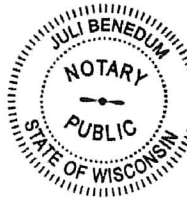

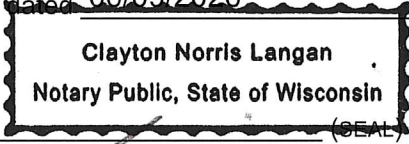

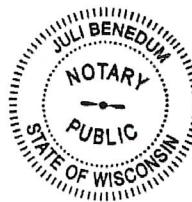
