Approve minutes of the April 22, 2025 meeting

Jacobson moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Lindman seconded and the motion passed.

Open bids and make recommendation for 2025 Asphalt Paving Project “A”

The following bids were received:

American Asphalt of Wisconsin	\$472,190.55
RC Pavers LLC	\$561,463.34

Lindman moved to award the contract to American Asphalt of Wisconsin in the amount of \$472,190.55. Jacobson seconded and the motion passed.

Open bids and make recommendation for Downtown Parking Improvements Project

The following bids were received:

Haas Sons, Inc.	\$247,004.07
Pember Companies, Inc.	\$280,482.20
Potrykus Construction	\$280,859.00
Switlick & Sons, Inc.	\$288,253.50

Lindman moved to award the contract to Haas Sons, Inc., in the amount of \$247,004.07. Jacobson seconded and the motion passed.

Drinking Water Treatment Facility PFAS Treatment: Ellis Stone Construction, Pay Estimate #17

This pay estimate was reviewed by the consultant and approval is recommended. Lindman moved to approve Pay Estimate #17 in the amount of \$73,006.00. Jacobson seconded and the motion passed.

Discussion and possible action on Amendment 8 to the agreement with Becher Hoppe for Wausau Downtown Mall Redevelopment

Wesolowski explained that Becher Hoppe is the design consultant for the Downtown Redevelopment Project and Corre was hired to do the inspection. There is some value in keeping Becher Hoppe on, for instance today they were at the weekly construction meeting to answer questions on the plans. The amendment is for up to an estimated 5 hours per week for the remainder of the construction season. There was a lot of coordination done by Becher Hoppe during the design and it is a complicated design.

Lindman feels this makes sense, especially if Corre has questions or needs clarifications on the plans. Wesolowski stated Corre has been calling Becher Hoppe for clarifications on plans or with general questions on the design. He feels it would be good to keep Becher Hoppe on for a limited amount of hours.

Lindman moved to approve Amendment 8 to the agreement with Becher Hoppe for an estimated amount of \$28,540. Jacobson seconded and the motion passed.

Lindman moved to adjourn the meeting. Jacobson seconded and the motion passed. Meeting adjourned at approximately 10:35 am.
