Date of Meeting: July 27, 2022, at 10:00 a.m. in the Council Chambers

Approve minutes of the July 19, 2022 meeting

Lindman moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Miller seconded and the motion passed.

Make recommendation for 2022 Street Construction Project C (Bids were opened July 19, 2022.)

Niksich said after reviewing the bids, staff is recommending going with the low bid from A-1 Excavating in the amount of \$639,639 contingent upon budget approval.

Lindman moved to award the project to A-1 Excavating LLC in the amount of \$639,639, contingent upon budget approval. Miller seconded and the motion passed.

Discussion and possible action on 2022 Wausau Municipal Parking Ramp Repairs – Sears Ramp

This item was pulled from the agenda and will be brought back next week to allow for further legal review.

Thomas Street Siphon Pipeline Crossing: Janke General Contractors, Final Payment

Lindman explained this final payment was held as the DNR wanted further review of the river bottom to ensure it was close to or met preexisting conditions. A survey was done in early summer. The DNR has approved that the riverbed was put back to their requirements.

Lindman moved to approve the final payment in the amount of \$47,220. Miller seconded and the motion passed.

2021 Street Construction Project B: Haas Sons, Inc., Final Payment

Niksich indicated this project was completed last year. \$2,500 was held as retainage to make sure the landscaping items were completed. Everything has been completed and approval is recommended.

Lindman moved to approve the final payment in the amount of \$2,500. Miller seconded and the motion passed.

Lindman moved to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Miller. Meeting adjourned at approximately 10:05 am.
