### **Approve minutes of the September 9, September 10, and September 16, 2025 meetings**

Groat moved to approve the minutes of the previous meetings. Lindman seconded and the motion passed.

### **Open bids and make recommendation for 2025 Wausau Water Works Asbestos Abatement**

Lindman moved to award the project to Robinson Brothers Environmental in the amount of \$90,390.00. Groat seconded and the motion passed.

### **Discussion and possible action on amendment to the agreement with Ayres Associates for traffic signal intersection improvements at Sturgeon Eddy Road and Grand Avenue and Townline Road and Grand Avenue**

Wesolowski explained that real estate and temporary limited easements are needed for this project. Because of this, the DOT is requiring an environmental document and design study report before they will allow acquisition of the real estate. We did not anticipate needing real estate for this project, but there is no room behind the sidewalk to put in the new bases. Because this is a DOT project, this requires a design study report and an environmental document, which includes sending letters to tribes and a hazardous material investigation. The amendment is a fair price for this work.

Lindman moved to approve the amendment in the amount of \$6,500.00. Groat seconded and the motion passed.

### **Wausau Wastewater Treatment Facility Screening Improvements: J.F. Ahern Co., Pay Estimate #6**

Work is progressing slowly as of late. This pay estimate was reviewed and approved by the consultant. Lindman moved to approve Pay Estimate #6 in the amount of \$84,048.67. Groat seconded and the motion passed.
