Approve minutes of the October 4, 2022 meeting

Jacobson moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. Lindman seconded and the motion passed.

Make recommendation on proposal for Hand Labor and Shoveling Services for Winter Seasons of 2022-2023, 2023-2024, 2024-2025, 2025-2026, and 2026-2027 (Proposals were opened October 4, 2022.)

Wesolowski reviewed the rates which were similar to past winter rates. The rates went up \$2 to \$3 an hour for labor and \$2 to \$3 for hand equipment with each year being progressive. He did not feel there was anything exorbitant.

Jacobson asked if this was within budget. Wesolowski said the costs are assessed out. The rates were not excessive and given inflation he thought there would be higher prices.

Jacobson asked who the bid was from. Wesolowski indicated it was from Revi, the same contractor who completed this work last year. Jacobson asked if staff was satisfied with their service. Wesolowski confirmed.

Jacobson moved to approve the Hand Labor and Shoveling Services for winter seasons 2022 through 2027 with Revi. Lindman seconded and the motion passed.

Wastewater Treatment Facility Improvement Project: Miron Construction, Change Order #22 & #23

Change Order #22 is in the amount of \$81,172.04 and Change Order #23 is for \$42,191.49. Lindman has gone over both change orders with Donohue. Lindman moved to approve Change Order #22 and Change Order #23. Jacobson seconded and the motion passed.

Wastewater Treatment Facility Improvement Project: Miron Construction, Pay Estimate #27

This pay estimate is in the amount of \$302,635.29 and has been reviewed by Donohue. Work has been completed and inspected on site. Lindman moved to approve Pay Estimate #27. Jacobson seconded and the motion passed.

2022 Street Construction Project C: A-1 Excavating, Inc., Pay Estimate #1

This pay estimate was reviewed by the project inspector. Work is going well, and approval is recommended. Lindman moved to approve Pay Estimate #1 in the amount of \$263,277.30. Jacobson seconded and the motion passed.

2022 Sidewalk Project: S.D. Ellenbecker, Inc., Pay Estimate #3

This pay estimate was reviewed by the project inspector and approval is recommended. Lindman moved to approve Pay Estimate #3 in the amount of \$134,167.83. Jacobson seconded and the motion passed.

2022 Alley Paving Project: Haas Sons, Inc., Final Payment

This project has been completed and staff recommends releasing the retainage. Lindman moved to approve the final payment in the amount of \$1,000. Jacobson seconded and the motion passed.

2022 Asphalt Paving Project A: American Asphalt, Final Payment

Work under this project has been completed and staff recommends approval. Lindman moved to approve the final payment in the amount of \$16,135.52. Jacobson seconded and the motion passed.

Industrial Park Force Main Access Points, A-1 Excavating, Inc., Final Payment

Work and final restoration have been inspected by Clark Dietz. Lindman moved to approve the final payment in the amount of \$3,000. Jacobson seconded and the motion passed.

Jacobson moved to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Lindman. Meeting adjourned at approximately 1:40 pm.
